Sponsorship Criteria

OEA Employment & Training only sponsors:

- Opaskwayak Cree Nation members
- Programs that are less than 2 years in duration.
- Programs within the Skilled Occupation areas, our department will not sponsor those applying for Adult Education or Upgrading. However, there may be options for Adult Education Upgrading through EI.

OEA Employment & Training requires the following for a “Complete Application”:

- Copy of OCN Membership Card
- Copy of Social Insurance Number
- An acceptance letter from an accredited vocational institution including Start & End dates. →
- The course costs which include tuition, textbooks and/or special equipment, this does not include school supplies or lockers.
- Copy of your recent school transcripts or copy of assessment results, if transcripts are unavailable.
- Provide two (2) typed reference letters (either Academic and/or Character) →

A completed OEA Employment & Training application forms.

All information must be submitted on/before the deadline of May 31st of each year.

Any incomplete or late applications for sponsorship will not be submitted to the OEA Sponsorship committee.
